Your online reputation influences how friends, future colleagues or employers judge you now and in the future.

Manage your personal information intelligently - use your privacy settings to adjust your visibility.

Search for your name online in Google or [www.123people.co.uk](http://www.123people.co.uk) to check your 'digital footprint'.

Create a 'Close friends' list to share with those you can trust while keeping it away from the rest.

Make privacy decisions on the fly as you post, use Friends lists to target content. Challenge anything that makes you look bad!

If you think your online reputation could be better, do something about it. Create positive content, for example a professional LinkedIn profile or a blog and don't leave it till your final year.

Apps can share your personal info with third parties. Avoid signing in to websites with your social network details. Check app permissions and thrash those you no longer use.

If you lost your mobile device, would your stuff remain private?

Sign up for a free service like Find My iPad, Androidlost or Prey Anti Theft. These will allow you to lock or delete content remotely.
